

Philosophy

Registration

- A current physical exam is required within six months of the first day of school.

3-Year-Old Preschool

Child must be 3 and toilet trained by September 1st.

Morning classes (2-day):

9:00 a.m.–11:30 a.m. Tuesday and Thursday
Tuition: \$180/month

4-Year-Old Preschool

Child must be 4 by September 1st.

Morning classes (3-day):

9:00 a.m.–11:30 a.m. Monday, Wednesday, Friday
Tuition: \$240/month

Preschool Schedule

Classroom Time, 60 minutes: Dramatic Play, Block Area, Manipulatives, Creative Art, Science Center, Quiet Area

Clean-up Time, 15 minutes: Organize Room, Bathroom

Snack Time, 15 minutes: All snacks are included with tuition and provided in a nut-free environment.

Group Time, 20 minutes: Introduction of Day's Activities, Story Time, Finger Plays.

Small Group Time: Show & Tell, Science Experiments

Large Motor Skills, 25 minutes: Held in "Blockroom," Gym or Outdoor Playground
Activities: Climbing, Jumping, Running, Skipping
Equipment: Balls, Scooters, Parachutes, Hula Hoops

Music, 15 minutes: Singing, Creative

Full Day/Half Day 3-6 Year Olds

- The remainder of the day is a blend of free-play, crafts, story time, gym time and music.
- Child must be 3 and toilet trained
- Tuition: Full Day \$240/week (\$960/month)
Half Day with lunch \$141/week (\$564/month)
Half Day without lunch \$110/week (\$440/month)
